4.1.Five-Year Designated Highway Plan

2022: Intersection upgrade of Route 845 and Norton Shore Road

2023: Pickwauket Road (Route 845) from Town Limit to Route 121

2024: Ravine brook crossing upgrade

2025: 1500m of Route 121 from Kennebecasis River Bridge towards Town limits

2026: 14000m of Route 121 from 2025 contract to Town limit

as recommended by the Public Works Advisory and Utilities Commission.
