1. CALL TO ORDER

4. NEW BUSINESS

4.1 Revised 5-year Designated Highway Plan

Mayor Doucet stated that due to the recent accident, and history of accidents at the Lakeside Intersection, Council asked the Public Works Advisory and Utilities Commission to consider whether the 5-year Designated Highway Plan needed to be amended.

Councillor Chorley provided an overview of the Public Works Advisory and Utilities Commission minutes from their January meeting.

Moved by Councillor Chorley and seconded by Councillor Tompkins that the Town of Hampton approve the revision to the 5-year designated highway plan, as recommended by the Public Works Advisory and Utilities Commission as follows:

2022: Intersection of Route 100/Main Street/Lakeside Road/William Bell Drive

2023: Intersection upgrade of Route 845 and Norton Shore Road

2024: Pickwauket Road (Route 845) from Town Limit to Route 121 (Pad and Seal)

2025: Route 845 Pickwauket Road, Ravine Brook Box Culvert

2026: 1500m of Main Street (Route 121) from Kennebecasis River Bridge towards Town limits.
