They also believe that social interaction benefits those with Alzheimer's. Nursing Homes without Walls is a new



program introduced by the NB Department of Social Development which provides support and social activities needed for healthy aging and quality of life. Keith and Randy believe that Hampton would greatly benefit from this program.
