

BY-LAW NO. HAM-2023-14
Ridesharing By-law

The Council of Hampton, under the authority vested in it by section 10 the *Local Governance Act*, SNB 2017, c-18 as amended, enacts as follows:

1. A by-law to enable ride sharing within the municipality of Hampton.
2. Whereas Section 197.1 of the *Motor Vehicle Act* states: “No vehicle-for-hire company shall carry on business or facilitate the offer of vehicle-for-hire services within the territorial limits of a local authority unless authorized to do so by the local authority”
 - a) If a ridesharing agency is in good standing and licensed by any New Brunswick municipality, they are authorized to operate within the boundaries of Hampton.
3. Hampton Town Council may prohibit the operation of a ridesharing agency within the limits of the municipality of Hampton on recommendation of its appointed Officers, when there are contraventions with this by-law and/or there are contraventions to other related by-laws, or it is in the public interest to do so.
