BY-LAW NO. HAM-2023-14 Ridesharing By-law

The Council of Hampton, under the authority vested in it by section 10 the *Local Governance Act*, SNB 2017, c-18 as amended, enacts as follows:

- 1. A by-law to enable ride sharing within the municipality of Hampton.
- 2. Whereas Section 197.1 of the *Motor Vehicle Act* states: "No vehicle-for-hire company shall carry on business or facilitate the offer of vehicle-for-hire services within the territorial limits of a local authority unless authorized to do so by the local authority"
 - a) If a ridesharing agency is in good standing and licensed by any New Brunswick municipality, they are authorized to operate within the boundaries of Hampton.
- 3. Hampton Town Council may prohibit the operation of a ridesharing agency within the limits of the municipality of Hampton on recommendation of its appointed Officers, when there are contraventions with this by-law and/or there are contraventions to other related by-laws, or it is in the public interest to do so.
