- 1. Call to order:** Deputy Mayor Salgado called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm.

- 3. Approval of the Previous Minutes:** It was moved by Gail, seconded by Jinell, to approve the minutes of the April 27th meeting. Motion Carried.
- 4. Business Arising from the previous Minutes.**
 - a. Trail Signage:** TransCanada Trail- new signs have arrived. Samples were shared.
 - b. Our Trail Signage:** Committee agrees that we will follow suit with our signs using the same sizing. Naming of Trails- existing trails are named already, the committee will discuss the naming of future trails.
 - c. Troy Summerville:** *The Leisure Services Advisory Committee moves that Troy Summerville's application to join the LSA Committee be recommended to council for consideration. Moved by Jinell, seconded by Murray. Motion carried.*
- 5. New Business:**

Cobble Hill Subdivision: Arthur and Bailey presented the proposed development to the committee and particular attention was focused on the Land for Public Purpose aspect. The committee has the following motions to submit council for consideration.

 - a) *I move that the Leisure Services Advisory Committee recommends that Council approve the Cobblehill Development Plan DWG: M1-A dated April 15, 2023, and*
 - *Recommend not to accept Greenspaces 1-2 (G1 & G2) as Land for Public Purpose*
 - *Recommend accepting Greenspace 3 (G3) as land for Public Purpose, conditional on the approval of NB Power for the intended use of the utility easement.*

 - b) *I move that the Leisure Services Advisory Committee recommends that Council table the Cobblehill Development Plan DGW: L2 dated February 13, 2023, for staff to collect further information from the applicant on areas that are intended as Land for Public Purpose.*

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Batting Cages: HMB would like to erect batting cages in Dutch Point at their expense and their maintenance. The town would permit the use of land.
