

## **HELP THE COPS HELP THE KIDS MINOR SPORTS BENEFIT TRUST FUND FUNDING GUIDELINES**

Funding is available for expenses acquired as a result of youth/minor sport. The Board of Directors is responsible to review applications as per its Constitution and By-Laws in accordance with the guidelines set out below.

*The HCHKids Minor Sport Inc. Trust Fund accepts applications for funding from the following:*

1. Individual Sport and Individual Team Sport
2. Minor/youth Sport Organizations

Applications are for those athletes who have earned their way to Provincial, Atlantic, National or International competitions. Applications must be submitted prior to these events to be considered.

Youth/Minor Sport Organizations can apply for assistance with equipment/assistance needs.

Only signed, completed applications, with the necessary supporting documentation attached, will be considered. Please complete the correct application, as requirements vary for individual sport and team sport organizations. Applications are available on the Town of Hampton Website.

Minor Sports Organizations as well as individual sport and team sport applicants must reside in the Town of Hampton or, be individuals who have participated in one or more organized sport in Hampton, New Brunswick, over a period of time, to be eligible to apply for funding.

Independent or self-funded groups (ie. private spring hockey), including school sport teams, are not eligible to apply.

Individual funding is to the maximum age of 20.

A team sport will consist of five (5) or more qualifying players requesting support to a maximum of \$500.

The Board of Directors will disburse funds from applications received when approved. Based on the location and requirements of the team or individual, a cap may be implemented.
