14.1. Orchard Hills Phase 9

Moved by Councillor Tompkins and seconded by Councillor Goucher that Hampton Council assent to the Subdivision Plan – Orchard Hills Subdivision Phase 9, prepared by Don-More Surveys and Engineering Ltd., dated March 20th, 2026, to create a public street, known as Hannage Court, to access fifteen (15) new residential “R1” building lots intended for residential dwelling units and a Local Government Service Easement intended for the stormwater management system.

6. ADJOURNMENT

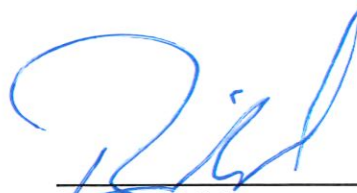
There being no further business, the meeting of Council was adjourned at 4:07 p.m.
